

**GUIDELINES FOR SUBMISSION OF PHOTOGRAPHS FOR
TEMPORARY DRIVER'S LICENSES**

1. **Clarity and Quality:** The submitted photo must be clear, sharp, and of high quality. It should accurately represent the applicant's appearance without any blurriness, shadows, or digital artifacts.
2. **Size and Dimensions:** Typically, the photo size should be within 2x2 inches or 35x45 mm.
3. **Composition and Pose:** The applicant should be positioned directly facing the camera with a neutral facial expression and both eyes open. Ensure that the head and shoulders are clearly visible, with the face centered within the frame. Avoid tilted or angled head positions, as well as any distracting elements in the background.
4. **Attire and Accessories:** The applicant should wear clothing that does not obscure their face or identity. Headwear may be permitted for religious or medical reasons, but it should not cover any part of the face. Avoid accessories such as hats, sunglasses, or headphones that may obstruct facial features or identification.
5. **Background:** Choose a plain, light-colored background that contrasts with the applicant's clothing. Avoid busy or patterned backgrounds that may distract from the subject. Ensure that there are no objects or people in the background that could interfere with facial recognition or identification.
6. **Facial Expression:** The individual should maintain a neutral facial expression with both eyes open and looking directly at the camera. Avoid smiling, frowning, or making any exaggerated facial expressions. Facial expressions should be natural and relaxed to facilitate accurate identification.
7. **Digital Enhancements:** Refrain from digitally altering or enhancing the photo beyond basic adjustments for brightness, contrast, and color balance. Avoid airbrushing or editing features that significantly alter the individual's appearance, as this may compromise the integrity of the identification process.
